mirror american political and cultural life
both reveal much about the material conditions
of the united states and its citizens
identities historical consciousness and
political attitudes lying dormant within these
festivals is the potential for political
consequence controversy even transformation
american political fetes remain works in
progress as americans use historical
celebrations as occasions to reinvent
themselves and their nation often with
surprising results in six engaging chapters
assaying particular political holidays over
the course of their histories red white and
blue letter days examines how americans have
shaped and been shaped by their calendar
